

Have you been delaying your IPv6 deployment because you don't have a portable IPv4 block from ARIN? If so, the good news is that once you register an IPv6 block, you can immediately qualify to get an IPv4 block from ARIN to help you deploy IPv6.

Yes, ARIN did reach full IPv4 depletion in September 2015 but prior to this, the ARIN community reserved IPv4 address space to be issued for specific purposes well after depletion. John Curran, ARIN President and CEO will speak about how to get your first IPv4 block from this reserve (typically a /24) and why moving to IPv6 should be a top priority for Canadian ISPs.
