

Cloud - It's Not About Hosting VMs Better, It's About Hosting Applications Better

Historically “cloud” has been viewed as the process of migrating servers from on-premises data centers to virtual servers running on someone else’s infrastructure. While this allowed for early wins in terms of consolidation and lifecycle management, it doesn’t fully leverage what a proper cloud deployment can achieve.

Modern businesses should be trying to consume platform services first and doing everything they reasonably can to avoid deploying a servers they can log into. And moving forward, they should be investigating serverless architectures where you literally don't have to deploy a server to run your app.
